This letter is to confirm the status of Mr. Jeremy Lambeth as the recipient of a National Security Education Program (NSEP) Boren Fellowship with all the rights and privileges thereof.

As an NSEP award recipient, Mr. Lambeth may be hired under the Schedule A Excepted Service Appointing Authority. This authority is specified in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 5, Volume 1, Section 213.3102 (r).

Additionally, Mr. Lambeth may be appointed to the excepted service with non-competitive conversion eligibility to a career or career-conditional appointment upon completion of two years of substantially continuous service. This authority is specified in Section 802 of the David L. Boren National Security Education Act of 1991 (50 U.S.C. 1902) as amended by section 1101 of Public Law 111-84 National Defense Authorization Act Fiscal Year 2010 (NDAA FY 2010) and section 956 of H.R. 4310-268 National Defense Authorization Act Fiscal Year 2013 (NDAA FY 2013).
